2024 PHASE I TENTATIVE TIMELINE




Table Partner Leads Proposed Options

The Table Partner Leads are 8 funded seats at 50k each

- Option A. Closed application
- Option B. Open application
- <u>Option C.</u> Consolidation of Table Partner Leads into Affinity Hub Leads
- <u>Option D.</u> Formation of a 7-person Subcommittee to Determine Table Partner Lead Processes

Option A. Closed Application

- To create a 10-year economic plan that represents ALL of LA county's residents equally and centers equity to ensure that the plan includes representation, strategies and solutions for all LA County residents
- This Proposal: A Compromise Solution:
 - Designate 4 Tabel Partner Leads for 4
 Original HRTC Identified UnderVoiced
 Constituencies: Women, Native american,
 LGBTQ and Gig Workers, A3 Table AND
 - Offer 4 Table Table Partner Leads to Sector Based CBOs or Representing agencies
- Tie the economic plan focused on high growth sectors, and
 - Address unmet needs of marginalized and disinvested communities
 - Foster greater community resilience,
 - Increase access to quality jobs and support LA's readiness to transition toward a carbon neutral economy

Option B. Open Application

- Open Selection Process for Table Partner Leads
- All non-profit/CBO organization in good standing with the state and able to do business in CA are eligible to apply
- Evaluation based on the following
 - Organizations Time/History of Operation
 - Focus Population(s) served.
 - Industry Sectors of focus serviced based on research
- Experience in the development and implementation of key workforce development/apprenticeship programs within sectors
 - Membership/Presence of organization in CA/LA County
 - Standing programs that target members of underrepresented groups in the industries

Option C. Consolidation of Table Partner Leads into Affinity Hub Leads

- Discontinue funding allocation for the undefined 8 tables
- Redirect the \$400k (previously designated for the discontinued tables) to the already established 12 Affinity Hubs
 - Each Affinity Hub Lead will receive approximately \$33,333 in supplemental funding
- Expand the duties of the 12 Affinity Hub Leads.
- Enhance involvement by promoting participation across all Affinity Hubs.

Option D. Formation of a 7-person Subcommittee to Determine Table Partner Lead Processes

- 7 Committee members
 - Develop the Application
 - Release the application.
 - Perform outreach activities.
 - Evaluate the Applications
 - Training/Orientation
